

# Neighborhood Association Registration

The City of Venice Zoning Code defines “Registered Neighborhood Association” as a neighborhood association that registers with the City for the purpose of receiving notice of land use changes and development applications only. Only neighborhood associations that meet the following requirements may so register:

- 1. The association must provide the City with a map of the boundaries of the neighborhood it represents.*
- 2. The association must be broadly representative of the neighborhood it represents.*
- 3. The association must be accountable to the neighborhood it represents.*
- 4. The association must have as one of its objectives the preservation or revitalization of the neighborhood.*
- 5. The association must have a governing board composed of elected neighborhood residents.*

As a registered neighborhood association, we request public notice for the following City of Venice meetings (please check all that apply):

- City Council
- Municipal Code Enforcement Board
- Architectural Review Board
