

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY OF VENICE ORDINANCE NO. 2021-32 WHICH ADOPTED THE OFFICIAL BUDGET OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2021 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2022; BY INCREASING THE TOTAL REVENUE BY \$142,200 AND TOTAL EXPENDITURES BY \$142,200; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the City of Venice, pursuant to Section 200.065, Florida Statutes, adopted its Operating Budget, Revenues and Expenditures, and Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Year 2022 by approving Ordinance No. 2021-32 on September 28, 2021, said budget being \$117,399,741; and

WHEREAS, the City of Venice increased said Operating Budget by the amounts of certain commitments for purchases (i.e., encumbrances) and projects, totaling \$22,104,996 and \$26,758,391 respectively, up to an "Adjusted Original Budget" amount of \$166,263,128; and

WHEREAS, the City of Venice amended its Fiscal Year 2022 budget by approving Ordinance No. 2022-01 on January 11, 2022 for \$1,450,000, said budget as amended being \$167,713,128; and

WHEREAS, the City of Venice amended its Fiscal Year 2022 budget by approving Ordinance No. 2022-04 on January 25, 2022 for \$337,000, said budget as amended being \$168,050,128; and

WHEREAS, the City of Venice amended its Fiscal Year 2022 budget by approving Ordinance No. 2022-07 on April 12, 2022 for \$414,000, said budget as amended being \$168,464,128; and

WHEREAS, the City of Venice amended its Fiscal Year 2022 budget by approving Ordinance No. 2022-13 on May 24, 2022 for \$3,922,796, said budget as amended being \$172,386,924;

WHEREAS, the City of Venice desires to amend its Operating Budget, Revenues and Expenditures, and Capital Improvement Program for the Fiscal Year 2022, as previously amended, by increasing the total revenue and total expenditures by \$142,200 as detailed in Exhibit "A", attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, of the revenue needed to cover increased expenditures, \$82,200 comes from General Fund Reserves and \$60,000 comes from grant funds.

WHEREAS, this amendment is authorized by Section 166.241(4), Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VENICE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 2021-32, as previously amended, which adopted the City of Venice Operating Budget, Revenues and Expenditures, and Capital Improvement Program for the Fiscal Year 2022 is hereby further amended as detailed in Attachment "A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its approval and adoption, as provided by law.
