**Important Notice:** Connections to fire hydrants at any location are prohibited except by the Utilities Department. Relocating a meter or any improper connections to a fire hydrant constitutes water theft and/or tampering and is a violation of the City's Code of Ordinance, Chapter 74-46 (e).
