

Neighborhood Association Registration

The City of Venice Zoning Code defines "Registered Neighborhood Association" as a neighborhood association that registers with the City for the purpose of receiving notice of land use changes and development application only. Only neighborhood associations that meet the following requirements may register:

- 1. The association must provide the City with a map of the boundaries of the neighborhood it represents.
- 2. The association must be broadly representative of the neighborhood it represents.
- 3. The association must be accountable to the neighborhood it represents.
- 4. The association must have as one of its objectives, the preservation or revitalization of the neighborhood.
- 5. The association must have a governing board composed of elected neighborhood residents.
