





City of Venice Centennial Celebration Plan 100 Years of History

Founded in 1926, the City of Venice is the vision of city planner John Nolen [WORD] the Gulf of Mexico, railway travel, parks and open spaces, roadways, and city spaces. Founded in 1926, the Centennial will celebrate major milestones, influential places and people and the community organizations and people who call Venice home.

- During the 1920s into the 1940s, Venice was incorporated as a town and then renamed to City! The first Mayor was elected and the Venice Army airport became operational
- In the 1950s through the 1990s, Venice Fishing Pier opened, KMI closed, and railway transport stopped
- From the 2000s to the present day, the city's history and environment have been preserved through beach renourishment, Fishing Pier refurbishment, and new government facilities






