Seaboard Site Visit

On June 26th, City planning staff, the consultants, and some members of the stakeholders group participated in a site visit through the Seaboard area. The walk took approximately two hours and provided a good overview of the area. Amenities such as the Intracoastal Waterway, Historic Train Depot, Legacy Park, Marina Park, Venetian Waterway Park/Legacy Trail and the Urban Forest were highlighted. Area landmarks like the Manhattan Produce Exchange building built in the late 1920's and the White Cement seahorse were pointed out. Potential plans for the City owned property were also discussed. The walk-through provided a good opportunity for all to get a good idea of existing conditions and to begin the visioning process.
